# System Requirements & Download

Before you install — check compatibility

## System Requirements

macOS Version	macOS 11.0 Big Sur or later (12, 13, 14, 15 all supported)
CPU	Apple Silicon (M1/M2/M3/M4) or Intel x86_64
RAM	4 GB minimum — 8 GB recommended
Disk Space	50 MB free space
DAW	Any VST3 or AU compatible DAW

# VST3 Installation

For Ableton Live · FL Studio · Bitwig · Reaper · Cubase · Studio One

## Install LusionTuner.vst3

VST3 Format

### 1 Unzip the downloaded file

Double-click `LusionTuner-macOS-VST3.zip` to extract  
You will get: `LusionTuner.vst3` — this is a plugin bundle (folder)

### 2 Open the VST3 plugin folder in Finder

Press `Cmd + Shift + G` in Finder (Go to Folder)  
Type exactly: `~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/`  
Press Enter — the VST3 folder will open

### 3 Copy the plugin

Drag `LusionTuner.vst3` into the VST3 folder  
Enter your Mac password if prompted

### 4 Verify installation

The plugin should now be at:  
`~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/LusionTuner.vst3`  
Open your DAW and rescan plugins to find LusionTuner

## Quick Install via Terminal

```
# 1. Copy VST3 plugin to the correct folder:
cp -r ~/Downloads/LusionTuner.vst3 ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/

# 2. If the folder doesn't exist, create it first:
mkdir -p ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/
```

#### ✓ TIP

After copying, open your DAW and run a plugin rescan — LusionTuner will appear under Instruments.

# AU Installation

For Logic Pro · GarageBand · MainStage · Reaper

## Install LusionTuner.component

AudioUnit Format

### 1 Unzip the downloaded file

Double-click `LusionTuner-macOS-AU.zip` to extract

You will get: `LusionTuner.component` — this is the AU plugin bundle

### 2 Open the Components folder in Finder

Press `Cmd + Shift + G` in Finder

Type exactly: `~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/`

Press Enter — the Components folder will open

### 3 Copy the plugin

Drag `LusionTuner.component` into the Components folder

Enter your Mac password if prompted

### 4 Reset the AudioUnit cache

Open Terminal (Applications → Utilities → Terminal)

Run the command shown below

Completely quit and relaunch your DAW

### 5 Verify in Logic Pro

Open Logic Pro → New Project → Software Instrument track

Click the instrument slot → Audio Units → LusionBeatz → LusionTuner

The plugin should load with its interface

## Terminal Commands

# 1. Copy AU plugin:

```
cp -r ~/Downloads/LusionTuner.component ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/
```

# 2. Reset AudioUnit cache so DAWs detect the new plugin:

```
sudo killall -9 coreaudiod
```

# DAW Setup & Troubleshooting

Configure LusionTuner in your DAW

## DAW Setup

### VST3 Ableton Live

1. Preferences → Plug-Ins → VST3 tab
2. Enable: Use VST3 Plug-In System Folders
3. Click Rescan → find under Instruments

### AU Logic Pro

1. Logic auto-scans on launch
2. New track → Instrument → Audio Units
3. LusionBeatz → LusionTuner → Stereo

### VST3 FL Studio

1. Options → Manage Plugins → Find More
2. Add: ~/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3
3. Start scan → appears in Plugin DB

### VST3 / AU Reaper

1. Preferences → Plug-ins → VST
2. Add folder, click Re-scan, restart
3. Insert → Virtual Instrument → LusionTuner

## Troubleshooting

### Plugin not showing in DAW

- Rescan plugins in DAW preferences
- Confirm file is in correct folder
- Check macOS 11.0+ requirement

### "Unverified Developer" warning

- System Preferences → Security → Open Anyway
- Or Terminal: `sudo xattr -rd com.apple.quarantine ~/Library/Audio/Plug-`

### Plugin crashes on load

- Ensure macOS 11.0 or later
- Delete old version first then reinstall
- Check Console.app for crash logs

### No sound / silence

- Enable MIDI input on the instrument track
- Confirm audio output device is selected
- Check DAW mixer — track not muted
